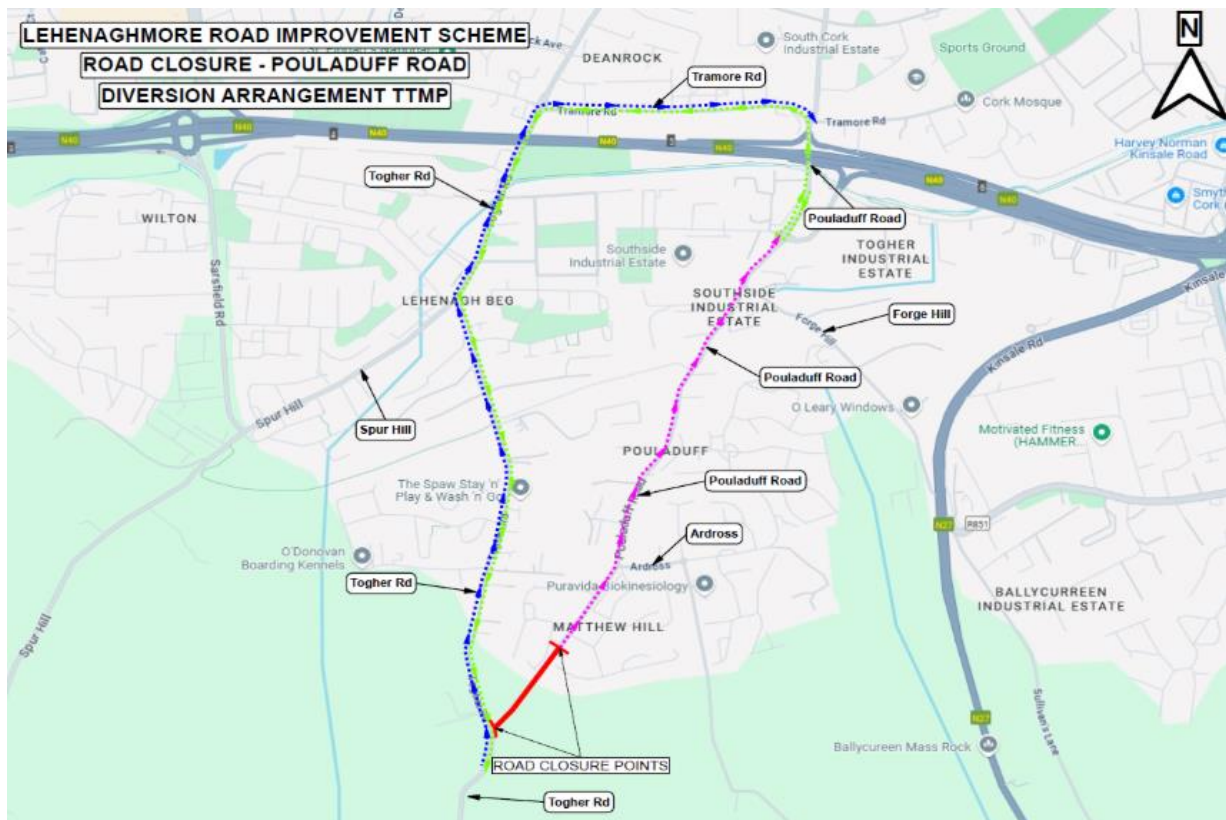
Update 25th May 2026.

4-day Road Closure on Pouladuff Road:

We are following up on our notification distributed on 1st May 2026 which highlighted the scheduled 4-day Road Closure on the Pouladuff Road.

As part of the scheme, between Laurel Brook Housing Estate and the new T-junction at “Barrett’s Cross”, the new design road levels are being raised from existing road levels (up to 0.85m, or almost 3 feet, higher). **To allow this work to be carried out, Glas CEL will utilise a 4-day road closure from 9am on Wednesday 27th of May until 6pm on Saturday 30th of May. The thought process behind the timing is to avoid a clash with the Leaving Cert exams. The closed section of road is shown in red below.**

We are asking road users to follow the signed diversion routes for the period of the closure.

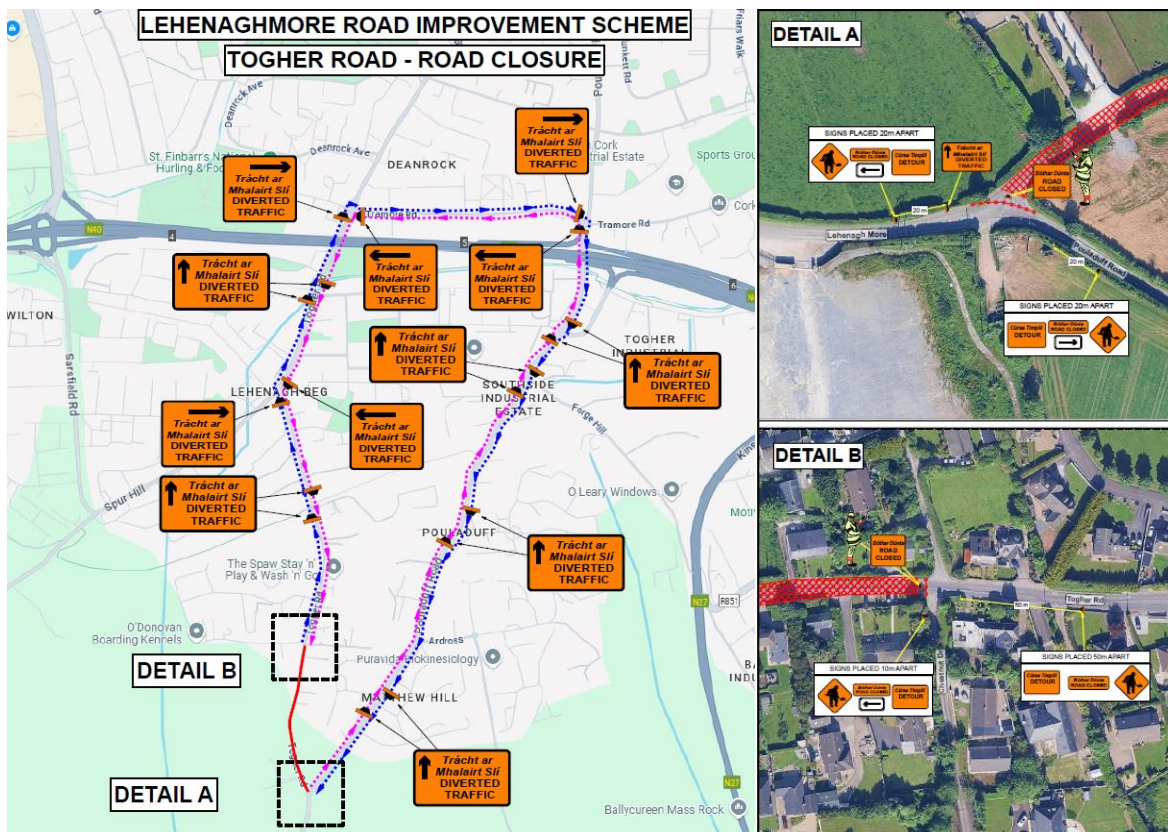




Togher Road:

As mentioned in the most previous update, the next element of works to be carried out will be the re-construction and vertical/horizontal realignment of the existing Togher Road, involving milling, excavation and resurfacing, from outside Route 14 Bar up to Barrett’s Cross. These works will be done using a combination of temporary traffic management comprising single lane traffic, controlled by vehicle actuated traffic lights, and nighttime road closures as required.

The nighttime road closures, which are required to facilitate the laying of underground ESB ducting, are scheduled to take place from Tues. 2nd June 2026 until Thurs. 4th June 2026 (3 nights) between Barrett’s Cross and Chestnut Drive on the Togher Road, and will be in effect between 19.00 each night until 6.00 the following morning. Local access will be provided for, and diversion routes will be signposted. Location of closure shown in red in the map below:



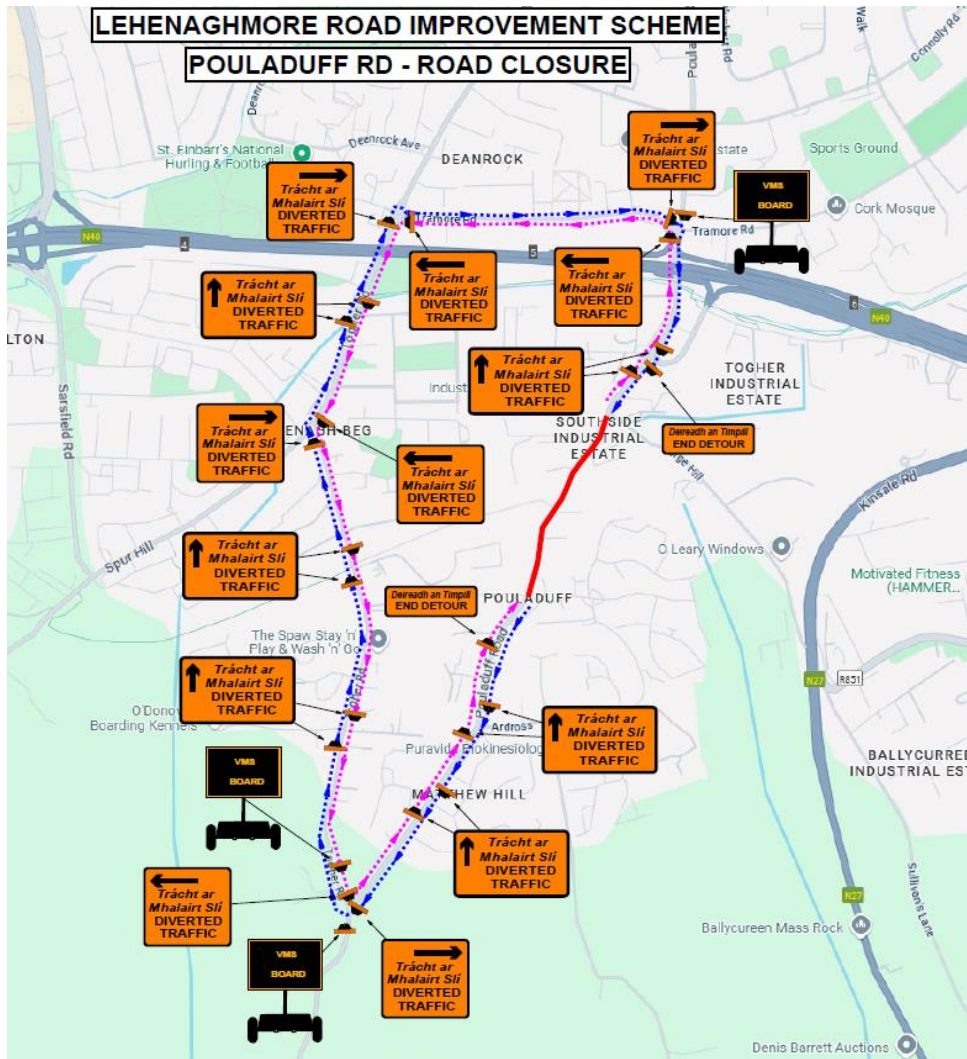
The remainder of the these works on the Togher Road will be completed under TTM comprising single lane traffic. This phase of the works is scheduled to commence on Tuesday 2nd June and is likely to be ongoing for 4/6 weeks depending on progress.





Nighttime Closure on Pouladuff Road (R 2455):

Nighttime road closures, to allow the installation of drainage crossings, are scheduled to take place from Thursday 4th June 2026 until Friday 12th June 2026 (7 nights – no weekend nights) between Forge Hill Junction and Dineen Crash Repairs on the Pouladuff Road. The closure will be in effect between 19.00 each night until 6.00 the following morning. Local access will be provided for, and diversion routes will be signposted.
